General Business:

Campdraft: At the school council meeting held on the 4th March this year, the community member of the school council suggested that due to this year's drought and the difficulties this is causing for many in the local business community, perhaps the school should look to hold a different fund raiser this year. This was discussed and decided that the P & C will not run a campdraft in 2014, all were disappointed but felt it would not be right to expect local business to supply sponsorship in this difficult year, difficulties sourcing cattle were also discussed.

The P & C secretary is to write to all the usual sponsors including Assefs and explain that the P & C will not be holding a campdraft in 2014 due to the drought etc, and to explain that the P & C will look to run the campdraft in future when conditions are better, and to also thank them for their past support and hope that we can count on them for sponsorship in future years.

Brazel 60th Wedding Celebration April 2015 – The P & C have been asked to provide catering for this event, it was agreed the P & C would cater, details to be discussed nearer the time.

Canteen- Parents are to be invited to come into school on Mondays and work with Kerry McNamara in the canteen, so they can gain confidence to volunteer for canteen duty, - to be put in the school newsletter.
