3-6 Excursion to Lake Ainsworth

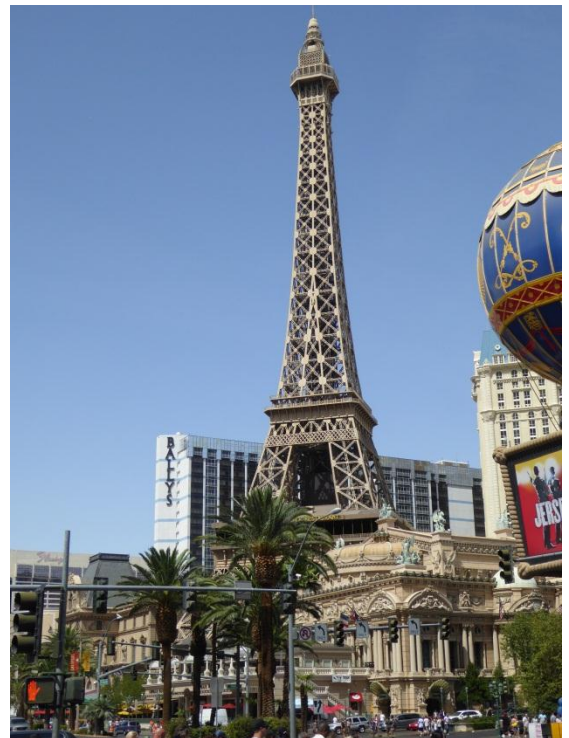
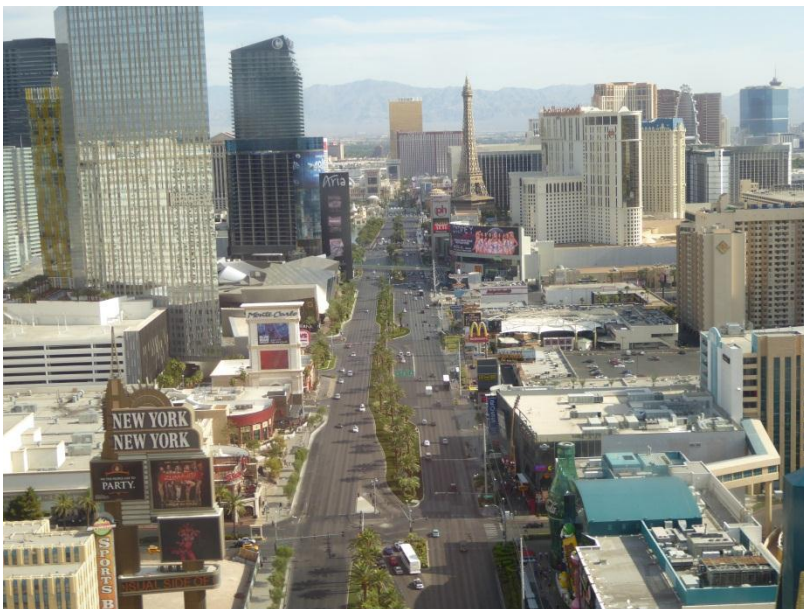
All permission notes should have been returned. The total cost for each student for this excursion is \$300. Parents can pay the full amount or pay by instalment. Invoices have been sent home again this week.
