Who is Youcef Abdi?

Youcef was born in Algeria but moved to Australia after visiting Sydney for the 1996 World Junior Championships. He competed for his first Australia team in 2006, winning bronze in the 1500m at the Melbourne Commonwealth Games. He then took up steeplechase and competed in the event at the 2008 Beijing Games,

finishing sixth. He then competed at his second Games in London, finishing sixth in the steeplechase.
