Year 6 Warialda High School

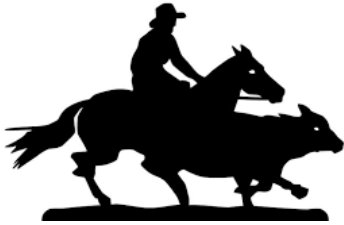
