Jumpstart – 2018 Kinda Orientation/Transition to School Program For Children who turn 5 before 1st August in 2019

Dear Parent/Caregiver

Each year Pallamallawa Public School holds a Kindergarten Transition (Jumpstart) to school program for children who are starting school the following year. This involves pre-school children attending the school for one day a week over a 25-week period beginning Term 2, under the supervision of Ms Pidgeon.

On Wednesday 21st March the school will be holding an orientation session commencing at 9.00am for parents who may be enrolling their child at Pallamallawa Public School in 2019. At this session Staff will be outlining the Kinda Transition Jumpstart Program to be held for preschoolers in Term 2, Term 3 & Term 4. The program will run for 25 weeks on Thursdays, beginning Term 2 Week 1, Thursday 3rd May.

This is open to children turning 5 before 1st August in 2019.
