Dear Parents and Caregivers

Term 2 Update and Planning,

At this stage directives from the Premier of New South Wales and the Minister of Education, for the first two weeks of Term 2, Pallamallawa Public School will continue to function similar to the last two weeks of Term 1. Work Packs were created for students to follow at home or school. This was a major undertaking for all staff working to ensure all students received a learning pack. Thank you to our staff who are committed and worked tirelessly to get these packs together in such a short time.

The first two days of Term 2 (27th and 28th of April) have been classified as Staff Development / Pupil Free Days. From Wednesday the 29th of April, the school will be open for students to attend each day. Learning work packs have been prepared for Weeks 1 and 2 available for all students whether at school or continuing learning from home.

As advised by the Premier, all students will have the opportunity to start attending school more frequently — with explicit face-to-face teaching and learning from the 11th of May. The School will be following the DoE guide for resumption of face to face teaching. **See the Timetable below**. The timetable outlines the days students can attend for explicit teaching from their classroom teacher. Please note the school is still open for all students each day during these weeks.

Operating hours for Term 2 will be the normal 8.40am to 3pm. Please Note: There will be no before or after school care this term. Staff will be unable to supervise students outside school hours. Staff will be involved in professional learning and preparing learning work packs.
