Dear Parents and Caregivers

Welcome to Week 5.

Due to the current situation unfolding in Moree with Covid-19, if your child or anyone in your family have any flu-like symptoms they need to be tested and provide a copy of a negative COVID-19 test result and be symptom-free before being permitted to return to school. Students who do not undertake a COVID-19 test will not be permitted to return to school for a 10-day period and present a medical certificate. Additionally, they must be symptom-free for a least 3 days prior to returning to school.

We are to operate as normal until further notice is issued to the school by the Department of Education.

Crossing Safety & Pick Up of Students

School Visitor Check-In- Service NSW App

As of the 18th October, there was a change in the way parents, visitors and contractors sign in when they enter Pallamallawa Public School grounds.

Volunteers (including P & C Canteen), contractors and other adults conducting work on school grounds will need to show vaccination status (Must be fully vaccinated by 8th Nov) WWCC to be verified and QR Code in. Parents dropping off and picking up students will not need to QR code in (brief period of time) unless they are attending a meeting at school. Then parents will have to QR Code in and show proof of vaccination status (Must be fully vaccinated by 8th Nov). 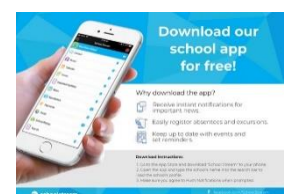
Moree Mobile Library Visit
