# School Visitor Check-In- Service NSW App

As of the  $18^{th}$  October, there was a change in the way parents, visitors and contractors sign in when they enter Pallamallawa Public School grounds.

Volunteers (including P & C Canteen), contractors and other adults conducting work on school grounds will need to show vaccination status (Must be fully vaccinated by 8<sup>th</sup> Nov) WWCC to be verified and QR Code in. Parents dropping off and picking up students will not need to QR code in (brief period of time) unless they are attending a meeting at school. Then parents will have to QR Code in and show proof of vaccination status (Must be fully vaccinated by 8<sup>th</sup> Nov).
