Dear Parents and Caregivers Welcome Back

Welcome back to school for 2021 and a special welcome to new families



joining our community. I hope you were able to enjoy the break and spend quality time with friends and family.

We were excited to welcome our new Kindergarten students to Pallamallawa Public School for their first full day of school last Friday. There were no tears and all classes have settled very quickly.

We are currently planning to hold a Meet the New Families afternoon, into our School Community (with COVID-19 restrictions) and will provide further information. If you have any concerns or there is something you feel the teacher should know about your child, please do not hesitate

to contact the office to organise a phone or formal meeting.

The Department of Education's guidelines remain very similar to last year in regard to COVID-19 and these include:

• Students and staff who are unwell should remain at home. Any person with even the mildest flu-like symptoms should undergo a COVID-19 test immediately and send the negative result to the school before returning. They must not return to school until they are symptom free. Students who have seasonal allergic rhinitis or another condition that presents similarly to flu-like symptoms are still required to get tested for COVID-19 and return a negative test result.

Where their symptoms continue beyond 10 days, students should provide documentation from their GP confirming their symptoms are typical for their condition. If the student develops new or changed symptoms, they should get retested for COVID-19.

· Parents and carer's are only permitted on site if they have an appointment with a member of school staff. If you wish to speak with or arrange an appointment with your child's class teacher, please call the school office and a message will be passed on to them.

- All visitors to the school site, including parents and carers must sign in using the NSW Health QR code displayed on the school gates or in the office along with normal sign in procedures.
- We will continue to provide hand sanitizer, remind children to wash hands regularly and continue cleaning resources after use.
- A physical distance of 1.5m must be maintained by all adults on site or while waiting outside the school.
- Students and staff are not required to wear face masks. However, they are permitted to do so if they wish.
- Students are encouraged to bring a water bottle that can be refilled to school each day as we are trying to limit the use of shared bubblers.
- · Assemblies will be held with parents.

We are in the process of purchasing a LED Sign to replace the existing sign. We will be able to display photos and rolling events on the new sign.

2021 Home Reading Scheme

Homework and home reading will commence for all classes next week. This year we begin the Home Reading Scheme to encourage reading at home. Students will receive raffle tickets to go into a raffle draw upon each 20 nights of reading.

A raffle ticket will be drawn at each Friday assembly with the winning student choosing a new book from our wonderful collection of book prizes. Tickets not drawn will remain in the draw giving students an increased chance of winning the more nights they read. Students must remember to keep track of their reading at home by completing their home reading log with their homework. Some simple tips to encourage home reading:

- * Read aloud to your child or take turns reading
- * Read texts that are of interest to your child This could include short stories, magazines, a dictionary, an atlas and chapter books
- * 10 minutes each night is enough
- * Levelled readers sent home from school will be chosen by the classroom teacher for practice.

 Your child will read more complex books at school with the support of the teacher
- * Enjoy reading together. If it becomes stressful put the book down and try again tomorrow night Happy reading and good luck
