Medication/Medical

Anaphylaxis, Asthma, or Allergic Reaction plans are required to be kept up to date along with any medication required to be kept at school. Please note that we are unable to administer non-prescription medications.

School Attendance

This year we seem to be experiencing a larger than normal number of children coming to school late or requests to leave early.

Arriving at school and class on time:

- Ensures that children do not miss out on important learning activities scheduled early in the day
- · Helps children learn the importance of punctuality and routine
- Gives children time to greet their friends before class

Reduces classroom disruption

Late arrival or early departures are recorded as a partial absence and needs to be explained by a parent. Any unexplained absences go directly to the HSLO to follow up.

Procedure for late arrivals and early departures: Parents must go directly to the school office to QR Code, complete sign in book and paperwork. Ms Hodge will then take your child to class or collect them from class and bring them back to school office. Parents are NOT to go the students classroom unless given prior permission by the Principal.

On occasions your child may need to be absent from school or go home early. Justified reasons include:

- · Being sick, or having an infectious disease
- · Having an unavoidable medical appointment
- · Being required to attend a recognised religious holiday
- Exceptional or urgent family circumstance (e.g. attending a funeral).

Parents must ring, email or send a note to school explaining why their child was absent from school. It is not the child's responsibility to tell a teacher why they were absent.

Any students that have their own tennis racquet, would they please bring them to school on these days.


Students will need to bring a water bottle to school to take with them.
