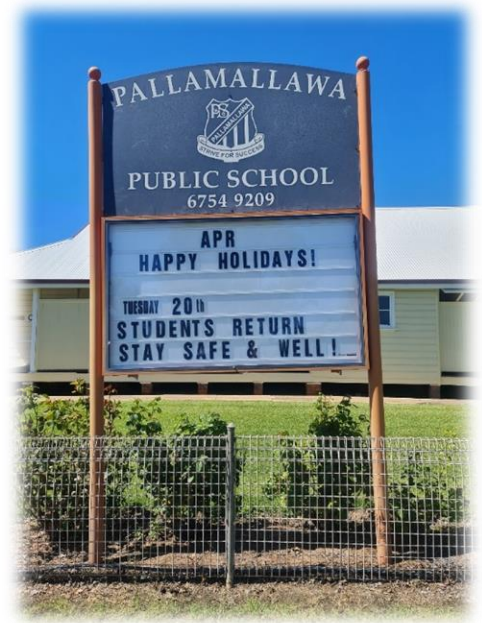
Home Reading
