In the know With Class 1 / 2

These three weeks class 1/2 have been learning to research a topic on an animal using their IPad and writing an information report on the chosen animal, what they eat, where they live, physical features etc. The reports will form a book that the students will be able to read in class.





Mathematics

In mathematics this week $Class\ 1\ /\ 2$ have been learning about choosing and using appropriate uniform informal units to measure length and area without gaps or overlaps e.g. using same size length of string or paperclips to measure the length of a line. The students were interested in measuring their height within the class, so we measured the lengths of our bodies by standing back to back and laying from head to toe.







North Star Public School Excursion

The whole school travelled to North Star Public School on Tuesday 25th May, to participate in the Sustainability Outreach Project with other small schools from the area. It was an early morning for students but from the comments made they all had a great day learning about the impact insects have on our ecosystem. Some students created a miniature worm farm, some discovered bugs using specialised equipment, others created a habitat garden, making and manipulating falling seeds, bird watching, clay sculptures and learning about entomology (the study of bugs).
