A Reminder to all Families

Students should not attend school if unwell, even with mild symptoms of COVID-19. Any person with any COVID-19 symptoms will be sent home and should not return until they have received a negative test result or after 10 days if a test cannot be taken and are symptom-free. In circumstances where children have other medical reasons for recurrent symptoms a letter from their GP is sufficient to negate the requirement for a negative test.



<u>COVID-19</u>

Parents please be reminded that the COVID-19 virus is spreading throughout the states. **Non essential visitors are not permitted in schools**. We all need to abide by the policies and guidelines of the Department of Education.

If your child is unwell, please keep them at home until they have recovered. If they have flulike symptoms they need to be tested and provide a copy of a negative COVID-19 test result and be symptom-free before being permitted to return to school.

Students who do not undertake a COVID-19 test will not be permitted to return to school for a 10-day period and present a medical certificate. Additionally, they must be symptom-free for a least 3 days prior to returning to school.
