The Merger was released on Netflix in late December 2020 where it achieved Top 10 status within a week.

Damian has released a young reader book, Weird School, published by Penguin Random to wide acclaim, delivered a new season of his cult hit Bodgy Creek Community Podcast and made guest appearances on the ABC/TV comedy series, Rosehaven and Why Are You Like This? He has recently completed the world premiere season of The Wine Bluffs - Decanted at Adelaide Fringe and debuted his smash hit comedy Double Feature at the Melbourne International Comedy Festival in April 2022.
