Did you know that regular school attendance supports students to be connected, achieve their potential and increase their career and life options. Parents are legally responsible to ensure that their children of compulsory school age are enrolled at and attend school every day it is open for instruction.



The Importance of arriving on time

Arriving at school and class on time:

- Ensures that students do not miss out on important learning activities scheduled early in the day
- Helps students learn the importance of punctuality and routine
- Give students time to greet their friends before class
- Reduces classroom disruption

Lateness is recorded as a partial absence and must be explained by parents.

What might happen if my child continues to have unacceptable absences

It is important to understand that the Department of Education may be required to take further action where children of compulsory school age have recurring numbers of unexplained or unjustified absences from school.
