EXCURSIONS 2024

We have booked our 2024 Canberra Excursion and Dubbo ZooSnooz excursion for 2024. We will be combining with Gravesend, Croppa Creek and Boomi schools for these excursions. 3–6 Canberra excursion will take place on Sunday 8th September to Friday 13th September. Cost will be set at \$450 (this may go slightly up due to some entry events fees not included until next year) for the first student and \$350 for the second and third students.

There will be no need for parent assistance required for this excursion. Mrs Hazell will be accompanying her class. It will be a fun and educational experience for our students.

Deposit of \$100 will be required. Payments can be made at anytime to the school. K-2 Dubbo ZooSNooz will take place from Thursday 9th May to Friday 10th May. We will be staying overnight at the Billabong camp sight. We will be combining with Gravesend and Croppa Creeks schools. Kindergarten parents and parents who have a child with medical needs will be given priority.

Cost will be \$140 per student. Deposit of \$50

Whilst we aim to keep our excursions as cost effective as possible, these trips are still a significant cost and we would give parents as much time as possible to factor in such expenses.
