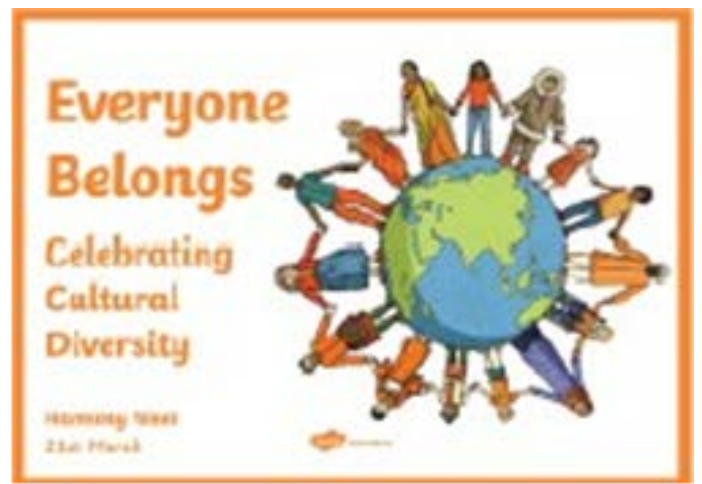

STEAM DAY-CROPPA CREEK

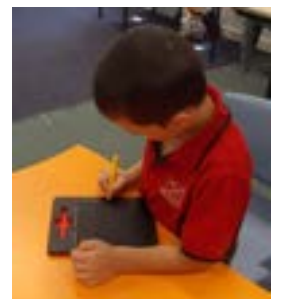

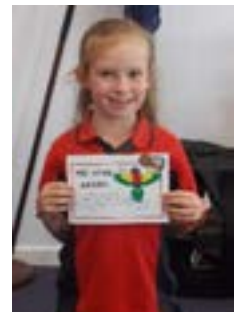
