40km/h School Zones

40km/h school zones slow traffic on the roads around schools. This is to help protect children on their way to and from schools at the times and places where they are often in high numbers. Most 40km/h school zones operate between 8.00am and 9.30am and from 2.30pm until 4.00pm. The 40km/h school zone speed limit must be observed even if school children cannot be seen. A 40km/h school zone operates on all notified school days including staff development days(Student-free days). While some schools may operate on different term dates, school zone speed limits must be followed during NSW Government determined school terms.
