PBL Awards: Georgia & Kade.

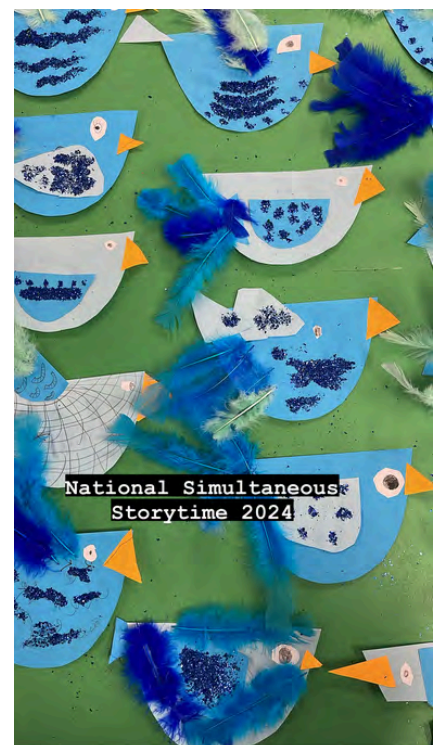
